Mrs. Daniel died Feb. 18 at a local hospital where she was taken following a stroke Feb. 15. She was born at Crowley, Colo., on Sept. 26, 1919, to the late William and Donna Nichols. As a small child, she moved to Wayne and attended schools in Wayne and Norfolk. She was employed for a short time at Hested's Store, then married Leo Daniel on Nov. 15, 1941, at Hebron.

They lived on a farm near Stanton prior to moving to Norfolk in 1953. Later they resided in Nebraska City where she did promotional work for Beatrice Foods. They returned to Norfolk where she was employed by Nebraska Christian College in managing the lunch program and as dietitian. She also worked in the hot lunch program of the Norfolk Public Schools. She was a member of the First Christian Church.

Surviving are her husband, two sons, Arvid Daniel of Houston, Texas, and Myron Daniel of Omaha, seven grandchildren, a foster daughter, Mabel Heimes Blatt of California, two former daughters-in-law, Mrs. Michael (Bonnie) Ward of Wahoo and Linda Hughes of Aurora, Colo., two brothers and two sisters, Robie Nichols of Sioux City, Iowa, Bill Nichols of Sparta, Mo., Thelma Rosacker of Westminster, Colo., and Clara Echtenkamp of Wayne.
