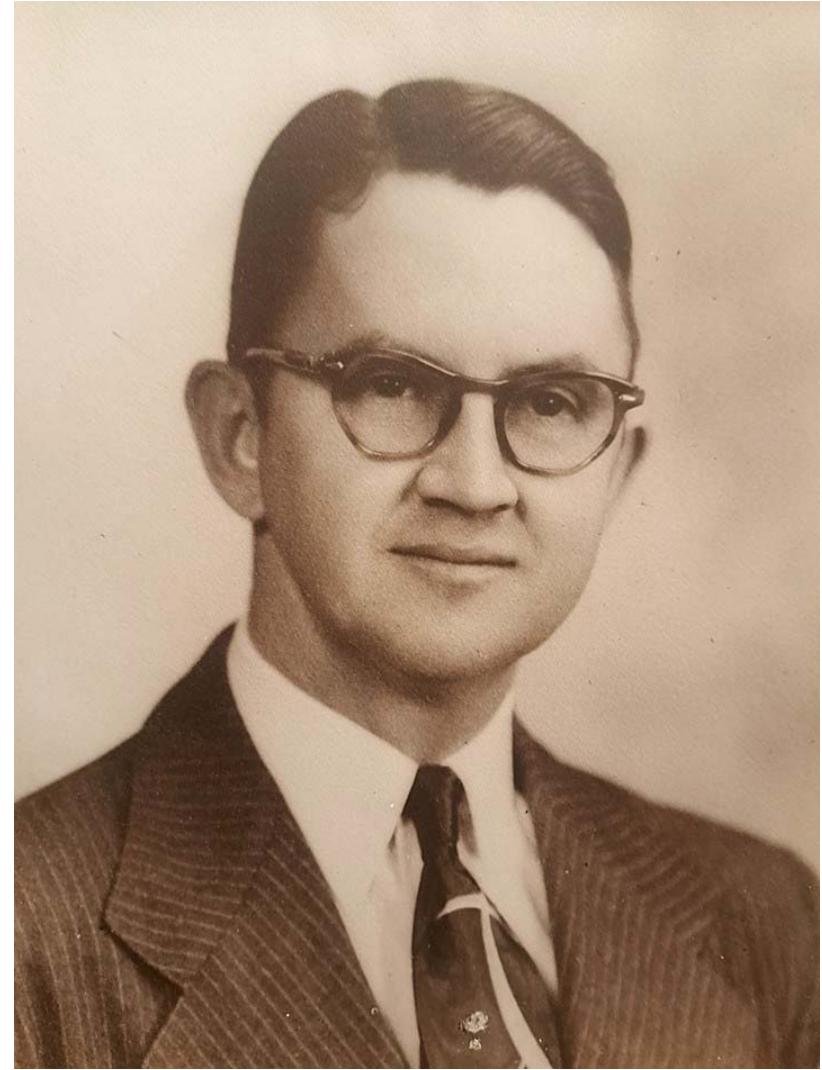


NCC Presidents



Guy B Dunning was NCC's Founder and first president. He came to the Nebraska Elkhorn valley in 1929 from the First Christian Church in Hammond, IND in order to reopen churches and establish new ones. Classes began at the new college on September 5, 1945. He served as President as well as an Instructor. Mr Dunning resigned his position on August 17, 1949 following a bad automobile accident in which he couldn't resume his Presidential duties.

C. Willis Schnelle was chosen as acting president.



C Willis Schnelle was appointed to the office of the President in April 1949. Mr. Schnelle received a A.B. from Manhattan Bible College and a M.A. & B.D. from Phillips University. He served churches in KS & Ok from 1936 to 1947.

He became Dean of NCC in 1947. He also taught Life of Christ, Theology, Homeletics, Greek I & Philosophy.

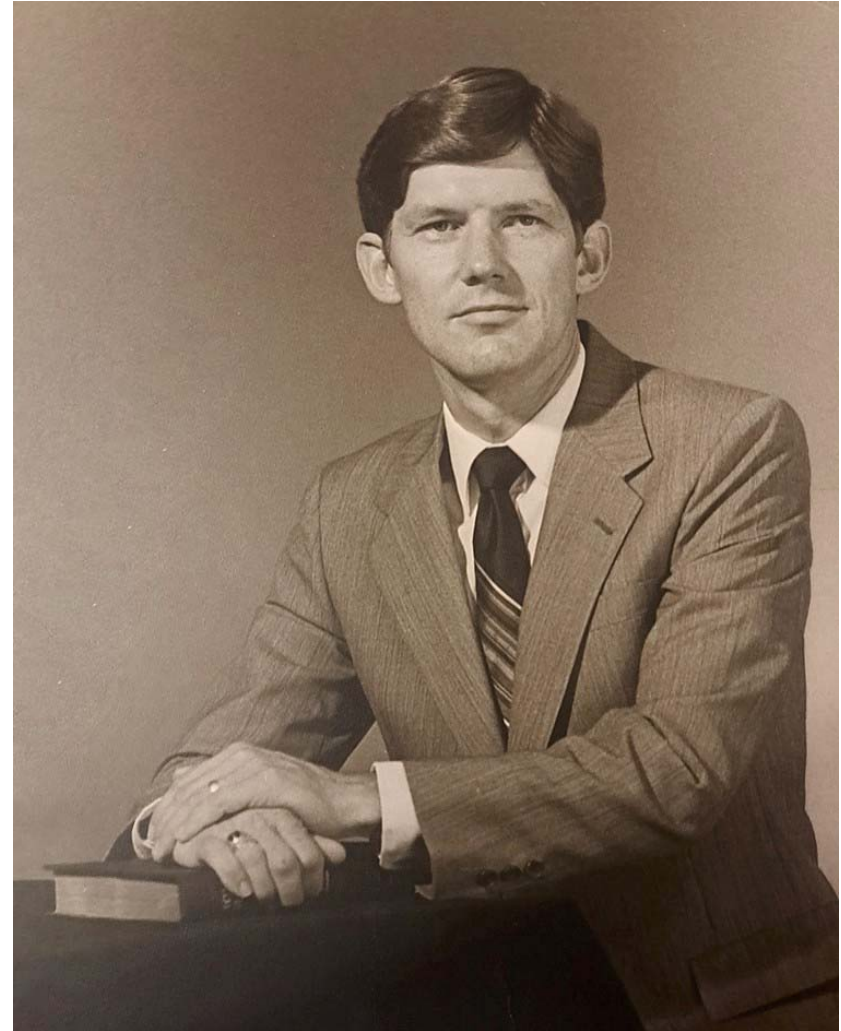
He resigned toward the end of the first semester in 1951.

NCC Presidents



Harold B Milliken joined the Faculty of NCC in 1948 as Dean and Professor and was appointed acting President in 1949 upon Mr Schnelle's resignation. The board voted Mr Milliken in as President in the spring of 1953. Mr Milliken was raised in Ewing, NE. He received his A.B. Degree from Minnesota Bible Colleg and his A.M. and B.D degrees from Butlher University. He was the Dean before becoming President. After 32 years in the office of the President, Mr Milliken retired on August 1, 1984.

Richard Wamsley was named President-Elect by the Board of Trustees.



Richard Wamsley came to NCC in 1976 as Student Dean and Professor for Pastoral Ministries. Mr Wamsley received his B.A. Degree from Lincoln Christian Seminary and a Master's Degree in counseling from Eastern Illinois University. He was working on completing the Doctor of ministries Degree at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. Mr Wamsley resigned as President in January 1990.

The board appointed Dwayne Johnson as interim President.

NCC Presidents



The Board of Trustees called Ray Stites to become the 5th President of NCC in April 1991. He assumed his duties as President July 1, 1991. He is a graduate of Manhattan Christian College and Emmanuel School of Religion with a Master of Divinity Degree. He served several churches in Kansas and Texas.

Ray resigned as President in May 1999.



Rich Milliken was appointed President of NCC in May 1999. Rich is the son of Former President Harold B Milliken. Rich graduated from NCC in 1982 with a B.A. in Pastoral Ministry. He also received a M.A. Degree in Educational Psychology & Counseling. Rich ministered in churches in Iowa and Nebraska.

Rich resigned as President in February 2014.

Tony Clark was appointed as Acting President.
