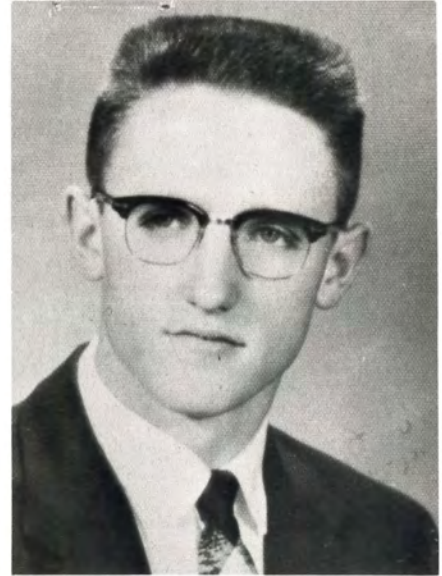

The N.C.C. Parsons completed the 61-62 basketball season with a 7-5 record in inter-Bible College competition and an over-all record of 7-11. In October the team made a Bible College tour to Manhattan Kansas, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, Joplin, Missouri, and St. Louis Christian College victorious over Manhattan Bible College and St. Louis Christian College while dropping games at Midwest Christian College and Ozark Bible College.

The highlight of the season was the Annual N.C.C. Invitational Tourney held March 15-16. Minnesota Bible College took first place by defeating N.C.C. in the championship game. Platte Valley placed third and Manhattan was fourth. Two Parsons, Dick Beedle and Dale Chitwood, were selected for the all-tourney team along with Roger McWaters, Minnesota, Ron Cook, Platte Valley, and R. Winners of Manhattan.

This year's team consisted of one senior, seven sophomores and seven freshmen. The team gained some valuable experience this year and are looking to greater things next year.

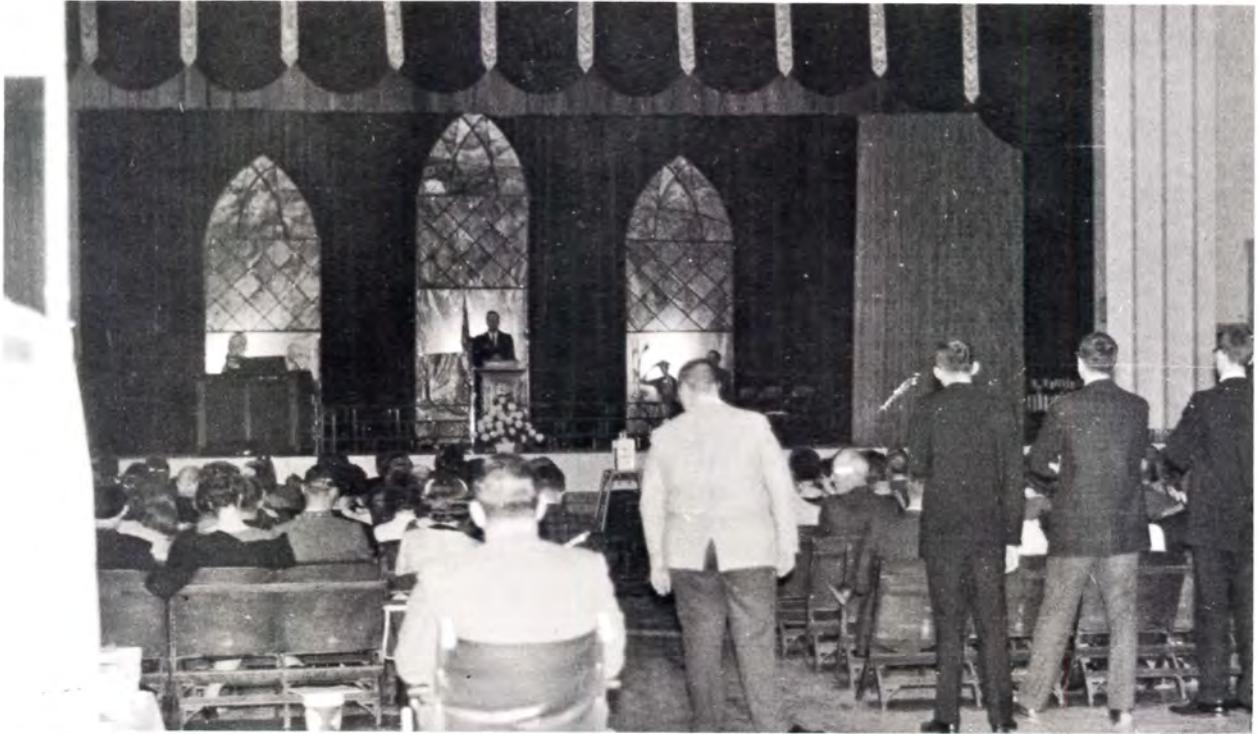
