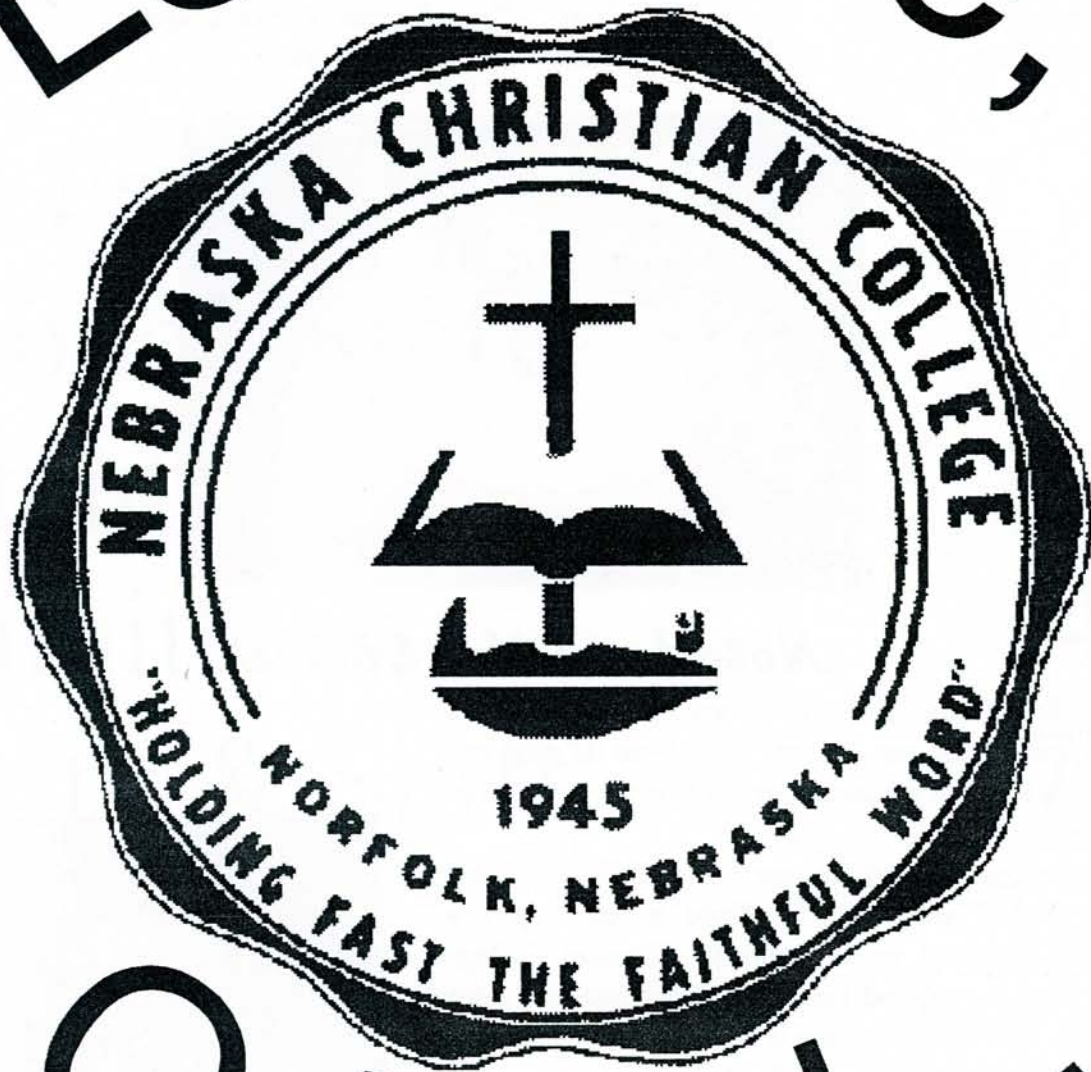

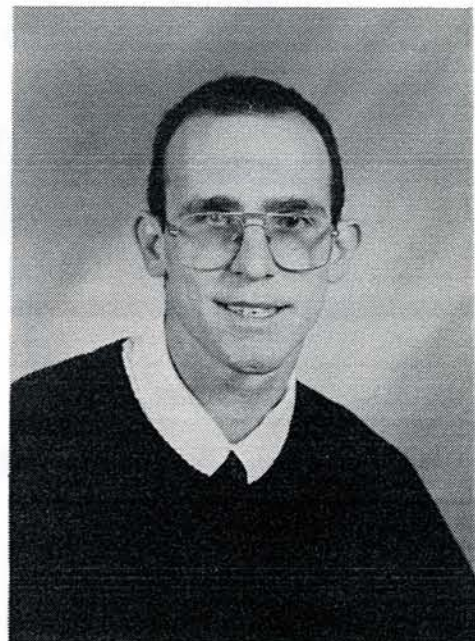
## *Note from the Editor*

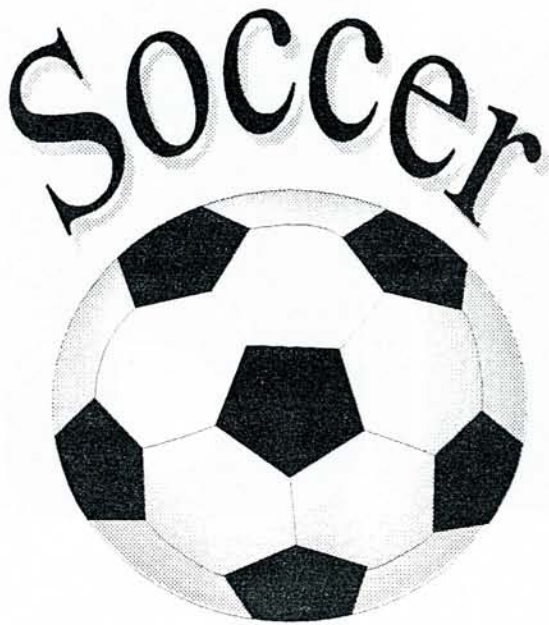


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# **CAFETERIA MANAGER**

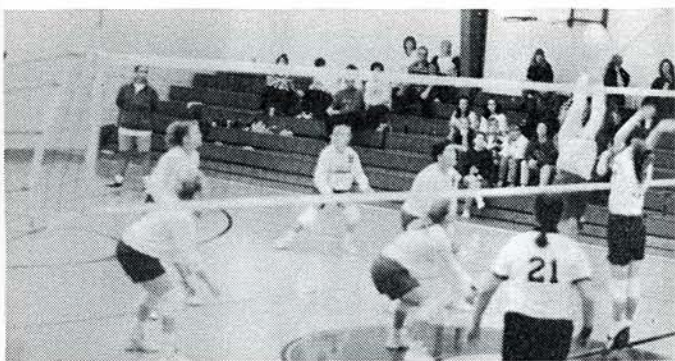

Of course each of these players played an important role, and received notice for it, but it also took help of the rest of the team who all gave their special part to help the team succeed throughout the year.



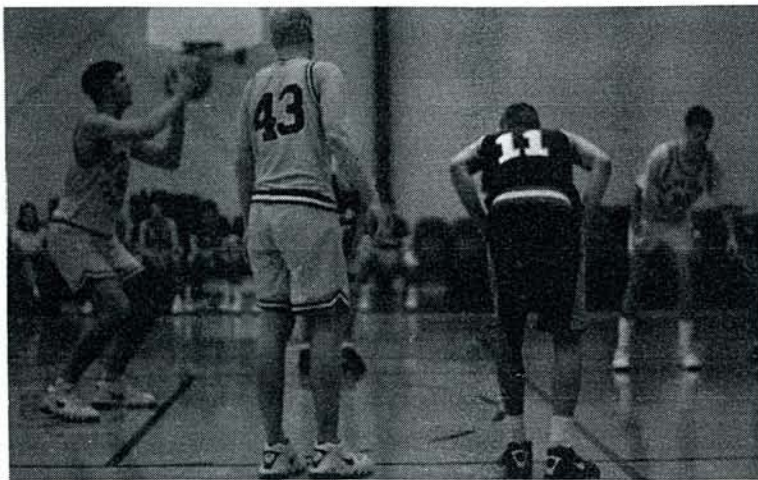
